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Keynote Speakers



Mireille Guiliano, a ground-breaking entrepreneur and internationally respected marketing innovator, served as president and CEO of the esteemed wine and champagne company Cliquot, Inc. for 20 years. Her casebook strategic approach to positioning and growing ultra-premium brands is often cited and followed in the luxury goods industry. Her knowledge of this business sector, combined with a unique perspective on life, food, wine, and travel, has resulted in two popular books, including *French Women for All Seasons: A Year of Secrets, Recipes and Pleasure*, published in 2006. A champion of women in business, Ms. Guiliano is active in the Committee of 200, an organization promoting business opportunities and education for women. She frequently speaks nationally and internationally on business topics.



Jean Chatzky, award-winning journalist and best-selling author, has created a global platform that is making significant strides to help millions of men and women battle an epidemic with a devastating impact – debt. Ms. Chatzky is the financial editor for NBC's *Today*, a contributing editor for *MORE Magazine*, a columnist for the *New York Daily News*, and a contributor to *The Oprah Winfrey Show*. The most recent of her five books, *Make Money*, *Not Excuses*, is a *Wall Street Journal* and *New York Times* best-seller. Among several national recognitions, she has been named one of the country's best magazine columnists by the *Chicago Tribune*. Ms. Chatzky is also on the Literacy Partners board of directors and lends her expertise to several women's services groups.



Dominique Dawes is not only an Olympic champion but also a champion for those she inspires and encourages. As the first African American to compete as a member of the U.S. Olympic gymnastics team, she has won three Olympic medals, including a team bronze in 1992, and a team gold and individual bronze in 1996. To date, Ms. Dawes has been awarded more National Championship medals than any other athlete, male or female. She is a coach, entrepreneur, international sports commentator, and actress. In addition, she is an advocate for health issues, athleticism, sports participation, and equality for women. A renowned public speaker, Ms. Dawes works tirelessly to inspire high self-esteem in girls and women alike as spokesperson for The Girl Scouts/Unilever Self-Esteem Program and the Dove Campaign for Real Beauty.
